


FROM SOUTHERN CROSS

TERM 3 IN KINDERGARTEN

Kindergarten has had a busy start to our term 3 learning. The children have been focusing on their own personal reading and writing strategies and developing their number skills, exploring addition, skip counting and teen numbers. The children have also been collecting data through the use of hands-on activities such as observing coloured cars or questioning their friends about their favourite pets or fruits. The children displayed this data through tally marks and pictographs.

We have aligned this with our HASS unit of caring for special places by collecting data about what resources Southern Cross children would like at the Oasis.





100 DAYS OF SCHOOL

In week 3 we celebrated our 100 Days of School! To mark this occasion the children dressed up as someone who looked 100 years old or dressed up with 100 items on their clothing. 
SCIENCE WEEK
