

It is essential to note that due to resource allocation and scheduling limitations, we will be unable to make additional changes or accommodate late requests once Photo Week begins. We want to ensure every family has the chance to secure these precious memories, so please do pre-register at your earliest convenience.



We aim to capture a range of photos by interacting with your child through play-based methods that capture real and authentic smiles! While we don't always get every kid to smile as some kids do not take to strangers quickly, we do our best to engage and interact with children through these playbased methods.







WRITER'S WORKSHOP


