STRONG FOUNDATIONS - YEAR 1 PHONICS CHECK

As part of the Strong Foundations reform program, ACT public schools will begin a phased introduction of the Year 1 Phonics Check starting with 26 schools this term. Our school has been selected to participate.

The Phonics Check is a quick and easy way for teachers to gauge the phonics knowledge of Year 1 students. It is designed to help teachers identify students who may need more help learning to read.

The first schools selected to participate were chosen based on demographic, location and size to provide a broad sample from across the ACT public school system. Insights from this first group of schools will inform a rollout of the Year 1 Phonics Check to all ACT public schools in 2025.

This is an important milestone as part of the Strong Foundations program designed to strengthen literacy and numeracy outcomes for all students. You can read more on the Education Directorate website.

KINDERGARTEN SCIENCE – INVESTIGATING MOTION

In Kindergarten science, our young learners have been busy exploring the fascinating world of motion. From rolling and sliding to bouncing and spinning, they experimented with different objects and surfaces to see how movement changes. Through playful inquiry, they asked questions, made predictions, and tested their ideas with hands-on activities.



For example, our kindy scientists filmed slow-motion videos to compare how a tennis ball bounces on a smooth, flat surface versus a carpeted area, counting the number of bounces. They challenged themselves building a ramp and bouncing a pingpong ball with books. They also had a lot of fun creating art by painting on a lazy-Susan and making their own spinning tops.









YEAR 1 SCIENCE – RUBE GOLDBERG MACHINES

To conclude our Physics learning, our year 1 scientists explored the ideas behind Rube Goldberg Machines. These are complex machines that carry out a simple task, as seen in this black and white image. There is currently a corridor display set up where you and your child can play with the provided resources to explore this concept. More photos are also on show below.



The year 1 children worked in small teams to create their inventions while also focusing on being collaborative team members.

Here is what they know about being a collaborator-

Lachlan – "Helping your team. Ask them what to do."

Esca – "It means where you talk to someone and find out the problem. Try to help them understand what you need."

Ollie – "Working as a team and helping each other."

Hadlee – "You tell your group what to do and collaborate to see if it's good."

Felix - "You ask your team."

Zahara – "You have to work together and agree." "Let's do it this way first, then we can do yours."















Our next focus for learning is the science of Earth and Space, where we will be looking to identify daily and seasonal changes and describe ways these changes affect everyday life.



YEAR 2 SCIENCE – SOUND

Year 2 recently wrapped up their unit on sound. It included lots of fun explorations into different types of sound, how we hear, and the ways we can "see" sound.

To demonstrate their learning, children created their own instruments, and they turned out great! They thought carefully about what kind of sound their instrument would make, considering both the pitch and volume.

It was great to see the variation in designs – we had instruments you strike, shake, pluck, scrape and blow.

Take a look at just a few of our finished products!



Year 2 have now moved onto learning about the Earth and its place in the solar system. They are exploring patterns in the changing positions of the sun, moon and stars and investigating why and how these occur.

Lots of great learning happening... watch this space!



YEAR 2 – PHYSICAL EDUCATION

In physical education, year 2 continue to work on their fundamental movement skills. Leaping and skipping were fun favourites that got everyone's heart rates up! They are currently working on strengthening their underarm and overarm throwing.


